

Professional conduct investigation results in suspension of an Associate (ACIfA) member of the Institute

Following an investigation into two allegations of misconduct against an ACIfA member, the Chartered Institute for Archaeologists found that ACIfA had significantly breached the CIfA Code of conduct. The breaches were of Principle 1 (rules 1.1 and 1.8) and Principle 3 (rule 3.6), and a sanction of suspension from the Institute for a period of one year has been imposed. Other conduct was found not to constitute a significant breach of the Code but warranted advisory recommendations.

The Board confirmed these findings at its meeting on 7 May 2019.
