<p>5.</p>	<p>Secretary's Report</p> <p>Committee members 2022-23:</p> <p>Cyllene Griffiths (Chair), Jonathan Berry (Treasurer), Calli Rouse, Ashley Batten, Rachel Morgan (Secretary), Jean-Yves Robic, Zoe Arthurs.</p> <p>The group have maintained our activities online this year in part due to popularity with the membership after a brief poll on Facebook (please follow us here or other social media if you don't already to keep up to date with the latest activities). The spring workshop this year focussed on Heritage Impact Assessments, Desk-based Assessments and Setting, with speakers from Cadw and Bannau Brycheiniog National Park Authority, and we well attended with some good feedback from participants. We have also had a presence at the recent Heritage Days at Brecon and Newtown hosted by BBNPA and CPAT.</p> <p>The autumn workshop after this AGM focusses on Cadw guardianship projects. This will consist of talks from Ian Millar of Salford Archaeology about their work at Caernarfon, and Ian Brooks of EAS about their work at Porth Mawr and Harlech Castle, and Jon Berry of Cadw on their role in the guardianship of monuments and a case study of Caerphilly Castle.</p> <p>The committee has also been working on strategies to increase our engagement with students and early careers archaeologists in Wales and would welcome any input from members who would be interested to be involved.</p>	

	<p>This year three of our committee members are standing down at this AGM, including myself, which means we are in dire need of new ordinary committee members to help keep the group running. It is a really interesting group participate in, and you get to experience other aspects of the archaeological and heritage community which you wouldn't necessarily come across in your day-to-day. We meet 3-4 times a year for about an hour usually, and also any involvement counts towards your CPD hours.</p>
