We have now received the recommendations from our small working group on the RIG Matrix and the whole committee are now reviewing the excellent work from Matty and Perry. If all is well, we will be submitting it to CIfA to consider our recommendations which included clearer and inclusive language.

Also in the pipeline is a Heritage Crime Workshop with the help of the Heritage Crime and International Practice groups. This will probably be in early 2025.

Sadly, the matter of ESRC funding for PhD's and that they expect the student to do a three-month placement as part of the programme had to be postponed to the next committee meeting as the main committee member steering this was held up in traffic.
