6.       7.	Elections to Group Committee and Advisory Council representative  Four members were co-opted to the committee since the last AGM. They have all put themselves forward for election at the AGM and no other expression of interest were received. 	The floor was opened for anyone present to ask questions, feedback or raise discussion points.  • Question around the public engagement toolkit and whether it has been/ will be promoted to local archaeological societies. Clarification that the toolkit was created by DigVentures on behalf of ClfA and promotion now sits with them, supported by the Community Archaeology Group. It has also been created primarily for those who commission community engagement within development-led projects, rather than aimed at community archaeology groups. There will be a second stage project that will focus more on publicity, but this is still being planned.  • Bredon Wilkins from DigVentures updated the group with news that DV is part of the consortium, led by Headland Archaeology, that will be undertaking post-excavation work for HS2 sites.  • Emily Johnson (Finds SIG Chair) said hello and that they are keen for our groups to collaborate.  • Research and Impact SIG also open to collaboration.  • Question asked about advice for issues with managing volunteers when problems arise, especially abusive/ bullying behaviour. This sounded like a difficult situation. Everyone should be treated with dignity and respect. Suggestions included internal organisation support/ management, BAIR Volunteer Management guide and National Council of Voluntary Organisations (NCVO).
